

We are seeking members for the NEW Ad Hoc Municipal Owned Water System Committee! The Committee will be tasked with:

- 1. Developing clear procedures on "Capital Projects and Major Upgrades" to the waterlines on the Kagawong Water System
- 2. Consider if a water system asset management plan and water rate study should be completed and how it could be funded
- 3. Review the current water levy and consider if the water levy should be broken down into operating and capital projects for the water plant and lift station for transparency
- 4. Review options for implementing a capital levy that can be used to create a "water capital reserve" to off-set capital costs associated with waterline replacements and upgrades for all benefiting properties.

Members must be a resident of the Township of Billings and own property that currently derives or will derive a benefit in the future from the Kagawong Water System.
