

A \$15 administration fee will be applied to all Credit Card payments.

Payment can also be made through the Bill Payment Services at the following banks: The Bank of Montreal, CIBC, Scotia Bank, RBC and TD Canada Trust. Credit Union customers can check with their local branch for set up and assistance.

A penalty of 1.25% will be added to any unpaid balance after the due date and on the first of every month until paid.

MESSAGE FROM THE FIRE DEPARTMENT

- It is important to keep your property open and accessible for emergency vehicles this winter.
 Firetrucks are over 8' wide and your driveway must be plowed to a minimum of 10' wide for fire trucks to access and negotiate turns. Please plow out a wide turn around for emergency vehicles as well.
- Make sure you have a working smoke alarm and CO detector on every floor and within your sleeping areas and to practice your escape plans annually.
- Regular chimney cleanings and proper maintenance is essential to reduce your chance of having a chimney fire.
- There are several local professions who can complete your WETT inspection.

BY-LAW UPDATES

Short Term Accommodation Rentals (STARs)

Application Information Packages are available for pick-up at the Township Office. To be able to operate a Short-Term Accommodation Rental operation, the Township is requiring property owners to have a license for each property that is being used as a rental unit (By-Law 2022-49).
