Public Works Reminders

With the winter season approaching the Public Works Department would like to remind all residents that when they are removing snow from their driveways, please do not push the snow across roadways in a way that will create ridges in the roadway. These are hazardous for the Township Snow Plow Operators. If you have hired a snow removal contractor, you should be discussing this with them. The home owner is responsible for the actions of their snow removal contractor.

General Updates/Project Updates/Grant Applications

The Phase 2 application has been submitted to the FedNor Canada Community Revitalization Fund for improvements to the outdoor rink. These improvements include site preparation, new professional rink boards, new player benches and stairs, new lighting and a cover. Staff should know the decision from the funders to accept or reject the application before the end of 2021.

The Phase 2 application has been submitted to the FedNor Canada Tourism Fund for waterfront development at the Aus Hunt Marina. Some work included in the application is new sheet piling and maintenance of the existing boat launch, and new docks on the west side of the Aus Hunt Marina. Staff should know the decision from the funders to accept or reject the application before the end of 2021.

Township Staff have submitted an application to the Trillium Community Building Fund to replace the pedestrian bridge in the Kagawong River Trail. *Please remember the old bridge is unsafe and out of order. The decommissioning of the old bridge will be included in the project.*

The Township of Billings has been awarded \$100,000, funded in part by the Government of Canada's Enabling Accessibility Fund, for accessibility improvements at the main entrance of the Old Mill Building. These funds will go towards the purchase and installation of new accessible doors and ramps to the Municipal Office and Old Mill Heritage Centre. Staff are currently working on drafting an RFP for the Engineering and Construction of a new accessibility ramp and doors at the Old Mill Heritage Centre.

Township staff have submitted an application to replace the Old Mill Road waterline with the announcement of a second intake for the Investing in Canada Infrastructure Program (ICIP).

Tulloch Engineering has been hired to complete a scoping report to help determine options for the repair or replacement of the existing Fire Hall structure.

An RFQ has been issued for a new public artwork display painted on the flywheel mounted at the Old Mill Heritage Centre Parking Lot. The RFQ submission deadline is Friday November 26th, 2021 @ noon.
