



MUNICIPAL BUDGET PASSED

August 2, 2023

The Township of Billings passed the 2023 Municipal budget at its Council Meeting on August 1, 2023.

Overall, the budget concentrates on maintain current service levels, completing current projects, finding areas for efficiencies, leveraging grant and funding opportunities while acknowledging staff capacity and resources available.

Council recognises that residents are experiencing the same inflationary pressures and approved a 3% increase to the municipal tax rate.

The average household assessed in the Township of Billings of \$234,380 would see an increase of \$78.23 over 2022.

Included in the 2023 budget are funds for the Firehall Rebuild project, Old Mill Heritage Centre Accessibility Ramp, Old Mill Road Capital Waterline project, Engineering for the Old Mill Road Bridge Replacement project, funds for asset management, the creation of a new strategic plan, website, agenda management system, bulk water, and enhanced benefits for staff in health and safety and professional development.
