By-Law 2019-31

Being a by-law to appoint a Municipal Law Enforcement Officer for the Township of Billings

WHEREAS Section 15 the Police Services Act, R.S.O. 1990 c.P.15 as amended provides that a municipal council may appoint persons to enforce the by-laws of the municipality, and that municipal law enforcement officers are peace officers for the purposes of enforcing municipal by-laws; and,

WHEREAS the Building Code Act, 1992 S.O. 1992 c.23, as amended, provides that the council of a municipality may pass by-laws prescribing standards for the maintenance and occupancy of property, and may assign to officers the responsibility of administering and enforcing by-laws passed under section 15.1 of that Act; and,

WHEREAS subsection 1(3) of the Provincial Offences Act RSO. 1990 c.P.33, as amended, provides that a minister of the Crown may designate in writing any person or class of persons as a provincial offences officer for the purposes of all or any class of offences; and,

WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Billings deems it desirable to appoint certain employees as Municipal Law Enforcement Officers;

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF BILLINGS ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. That Arthur Moran be appointed as a Municipal Law Enforcement Officer for the Corporation of the Township of Billings.
2. That employees appointed as Municipal Law Enforcement Officers are designated by the Township to act as Provincial Offences Officers in accordance with any specific or general directive of the Solicitor General for Ontario in effect from time to time relating to the power of municipal employees to act as Provincial Offences Officers.
3. That the CAO/Clerk be authorized to issue a certificate of appointment bearing his/her signature or facsimile thereof the Officer appointed by this By-law.
4. That the CAO/Clerk be authorized to execute the employment contract attached hereto as Schedule 'A'.
5. That the provisions of this By-law shall come into force and take effect upon third reading thereof.
