



COUNCIL MEETING HIGHLIGHTS

Regular Council Meeting: July 4th, 2023

- **Planning Application Approvals**
 - Council approved a zoning amendment request to fulfill conditions for a severance application for Part Lot 30, Conc, XIV (Beach Street) to create three rural residential lots that will permit seasonal dwellings.
 - Council approved amending the zoning by-law to permit a guest cabin for human habitation where a dwelling or seasonal dwelling is a permitted use.
 - Council has recommended approval to the Manitoulin Planning Board for two severance requests; creation of two lots at 451 Maple Point and one new lot to be created at 69 Foxtower Road.
- **Cedar Maze Public Engagement**
 - Council approved a recommendation from the Parks, Recreation and Wellness Committee to install a community chalkboard at the Cedar Maze along Henry Drive to seek community input on reinventing the Cedar Maze.
 - Those who frequent the area can write their ideas on how they would like the space to be used
 - Stay tuned for more details!
- **Oakville Enterprises Corporation Public Open House**
 - A Public Open House has been scheduled for a presentation from Oakville Enterprises on Tuesday August 8th, 2023 @ 2pm at the Park Centre.
 - The presentation will include:
 - OEC's obligation to manage water levels
 - Water Management Plan & the "Rule Curve" (what it all means)
 - Math: flows thru the turbine & the dam, and their influence on lake levels
 - Members of the public will have the opportunity to ask questions and will gain a better understanding of the generating station and the lake levels.
