Fire Department Reminders

Please ensure that you contact the Township Office to obtain your Burn Permit as per Township By-law #2020-16. There is no fee for obtaining a Burn Permit and Burn Permits are not required for Bonfires.

Please ensure that your driveway access is wide enough for emergency response vehicles. If your driveway or private road is too narrow, steep or unsafe for emergency response vehicles, these vehicles may not be able to access your property in the event of an emergency.

General Updates/Project Updates/Grant Applications

The Phase 2 application has been submitted to the FedNor Canada Community Revitalization Fund for improvements to the outdoor rink. These improvements include site preparation, new professional rink boards, new player benches and stairs, new lighting and a cover.

The Phase 2 application has been submitted to the FedNor Canada Tourism Fund for waterfront development at the Aus Hunt Marina. Some work included in the application is new sheet piling and maintenance of the existing boat launch at the Aus Hunt Marina.

Township Staff have submitted an application to the Trillium Community Building Fund to replace the pedestrian bridge in the Kagawong River Trail. ***Please remember the old bridge is unsafe and out of order. The decommissioning of the old bridge will be included in the application.***

Township staff have submitted an application to replace the Old Mill Road waterline with the announcement of a second intake for the Investing in Canada Infrastructure Program (ICIP).

Township Staff are working on an RFP for an engineered design of the Fire Hall Renovations. Completing the engineering will allow for rapid implementation of this project when funding becomes available.

An RFQ will be issued shortly for a new public artwork display painted on the flywheel mounted at the Old Mill Heritage Centre Parking Lot.

The Main Street Reconstruction project is coming to a close!

Some finishing work to be completed include:

- Handrails to be installed on all the retaining walls. This back-ordered materials have arrived and will be installed in early October
- Minor deficiency work/clean-up

Upon project completion, staff will have a debriefing session internally, and with the project engineers. Council may want to consider a dedicated Town Hall de-brief with the public. We will have more infrastructure projects in the future, so a follow-up town hall session, is an opportunity for communication and learning.

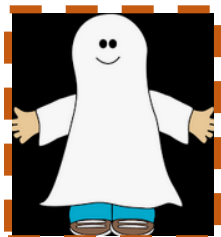
